



Redruth School celebrates excellent GCSE results

Redruth School are celebrating after achieving superb results. 80% of all students taking a new more rigorous English exam achieved a grade C (4) or above, with almost 60% achieving the new tougher grade of a B (5). 72% of all students taking the new more rigorous and more demanding Maths exam achieved a grade C (4) or above, with 55% again achieving the new tougher grade of a B (5). Overall, 2 out of every 3 students achieved at least 5 good GCSEs at grade C and above, including English and maths. In 18 subjects, at least 70% of students gained grades of between A* - C. Early indications indicate that once again the progress of all students at the school from their starting point to their eventual GCSE outcomes is excellent.
