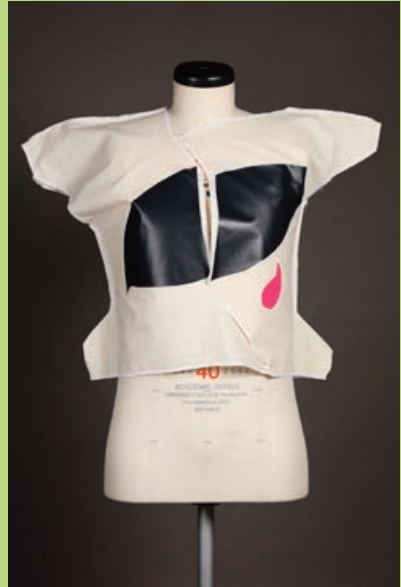


several issues under discussion, including an end of year fundraiser.

Year 10 Textile students visited Falmouth College to design and make abstract garments. The outcomes were stunning with bold colour prints and futuristic shapes.

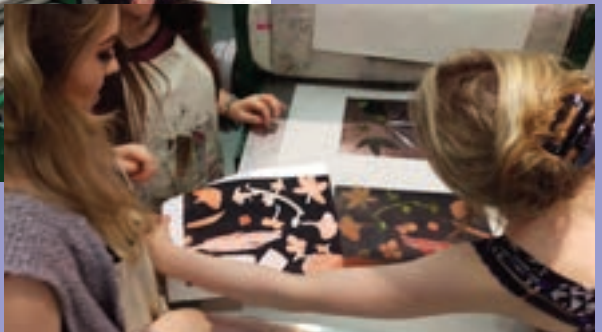


Penwith College
