Dear Parent/Carer

After two highly successful years of the London trip taking place, we are in a position to once again offer students the exciting opportunity to take part in a creative and cultural visit to London from 12 to 14 July 2017. This educational trip will include a day visiting the Magical Harry Potter Studios, where students will be able to see where the movies were staged and filmed and how the sets, props and costumes were created.

The trip will also include a visit to see a popular West End show, and a film showing at the BFI IMAX cinema. There will also be the opportunity to visit the London Dungeons, take a flight on the London Eye and cruise down the river Thames on a guided tour, seeing all the sights that London has to offer and taking in the history of our capital city.

On the final day we will visit Longleat Safari Park where students can visit the house, tour the safari park and take a boat trip on the lake, viewing sea lions, hippos and gorillas housed on the central island. It is anticipated that students will stay in a Premier Inn (subject to availability), where they will have breakfast provided each morning. The cost will be approximately £370. This will include travel by coach to and from Redruth school; evening meals at well-known family restaurants and packed lunches on the Thursday and Friday.

A £100 deposit needs to be paid by the Friday, 27 January 2017 to secure a place. After this there will be three payments of £90, with the final payment due on the Friday, 28 April 2017. Payments can be made securely online by visiting Parent Pay (see www.parentpay.com) using your previously issued unique login and password. Alternatively, payments can be made by cash or cheque (payable to Redruth School) to the finance office.

Students will need to bring food for travelling on the Wednesday. We also advise students to bring spending money of around £50 – £100.

We will be holding a parent evening nearer the time to give out itineraries and answer any questions you may have.
